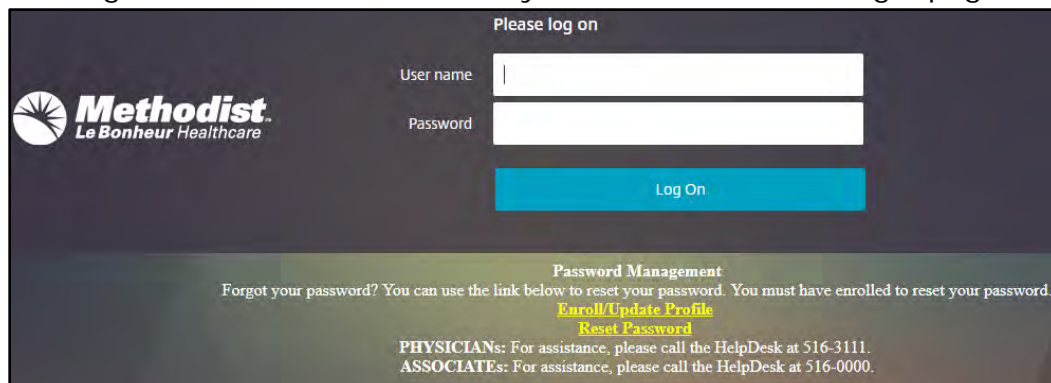
Overview of Website Updates

- Under the **Apps** heading, the **OneChart - includes Cerner** link provides access to PowerChart, Cerner and other role-based applications. The **MyApps** link provides access to clinical applications, knowledge links and non-clinical applications.

If you previously accessed myApps, using a bookmark, the bookmark will no longer work. You must access via www.methodistmd.org.



- Clicking the **oneChart** link directs you first to the Citrix Login page.



a. For Windows Users:

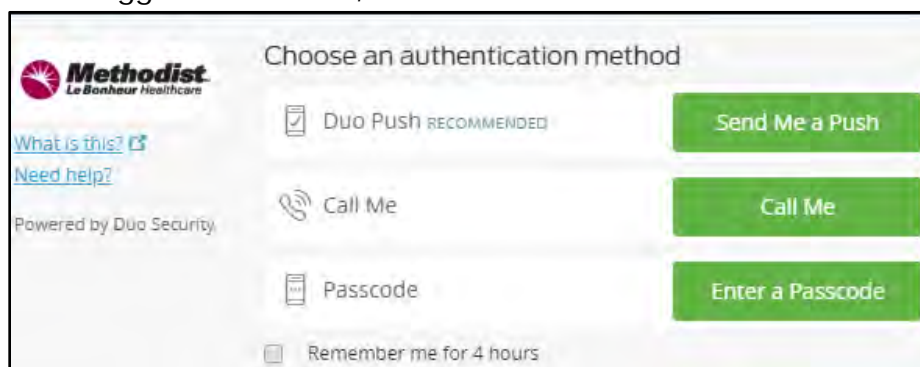
You must be running **Citrix Receiver 4.7 up to Receiver 4.9** (Windows 4.10 has

not been validated by Cerner). You can download this version from www.methodistmd.org.

b. For Mac Users:

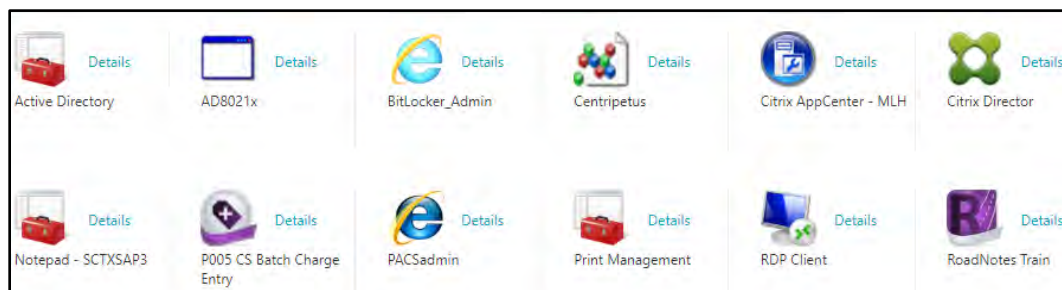
- You must be running **Citrix Receiver version 12.1.1 up to 12.9.1**.
- Citrix Workspace for Mac 19.10.x is currently in the validation phase with Cerner.
- macOS Catalina has not been validated and currently does not work with Citrix/Cerner.

3. Once logged in to Citrix, choose an authentication method.

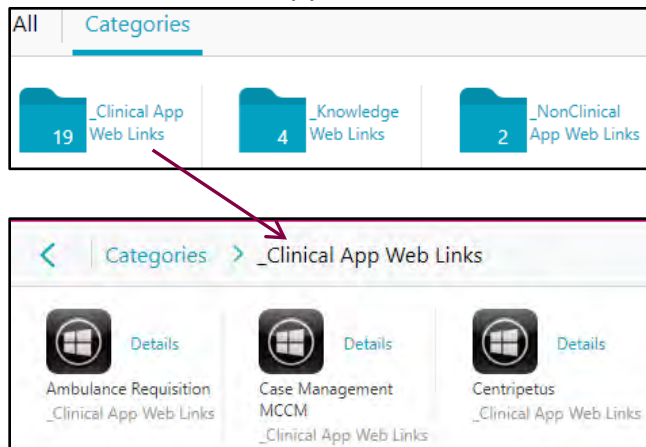


4. After successful login, your list of Cerner applications will render.

NOTE: The list of icons are based on your role/access and may vary from the icons listed below.



5. Access to Clinical Apps is still available via the **Categories** option at the top of the screen.
