Cigna Healthcare and UnitedHealthcare BOTH to Cut Precert Requirements

Cigna Healthcare has announced the removal of precertification requirements for more than 1,100 medical services since 2020 for US Commercial and IFP (Individual & Family Plan) customers resulting in precertification applying to less than four percent of medical services for these customers.

UnitedHealthcare has announced that they will begin a two-phased approach to eliminate nearly 20% of their overall prior authorization volume across all plans.

Eliminated codes will not be the same for each plan, so please consult their lists for specific benefit plans.

In 2024, UHC states they intend to institute a Gold Card program for provider groups that meet eligibility requirements, to allow them to follow a simple notification process, rather than prior authorization.
