# Billing the New G2211 and G0136 Codes

## G2211 Add on to E&M Code for Time and Intensity

After decreasing the conversion factor again, the CMS 2024 Physician Fee Schedule, by way of the G2211 code, is paying for the extra thought and work involved with caring for patients with complex/complicated health problems over time. CMS expects to see this code reported on up to about 40% of all E&M visits.

CMS states that the continuing doctor/patient relationship is the most important factor to determine appropriate of billing of this code, but more concrete rules for reporting G2211 are:

- 1. This code may only be added on to an E&M outpatient visit
- 2. This code CANNOT be billed with a 99211 nurse visit
- 3. This code can NEVER be added on to an E&M visit that has a 25 modifier on it.
- 4. This code may be billed only when chronic/complex conditions are documented AND considered or addressed in the E/M of the patient, thus figuring into the medical decision making for that encounter.

You CAN report this code as a primary care or specialty provider without limits to frequency at this time.

## G0136: SDOH ASSESSMENT

Now that Medicare pays for an optional SDOH assessment with the AWV, G0136 can add \$17.22 in TN and \$16.75 in MS (variation by MAC). But be aware of the difference between a screen that is performed on every patient vs an assessment, which is only performed and reported when there are known or suspected patient needs for housing, food, transportation or utilities impacting their diagnosis or treatment. The questions are the same, but the patient circumstances are not.
