

To continue your electronic health record access after the Oct 5 Epic implementation:

IF YOU HAVE FULL PRIVILEGES NOW BUT NO LONGER PRACTICE WITHIN AN MLH FACILITY OR INTEND TO DISCONTINUE PRACTICING WITHIN AN MLH FACILITY BY OCT 5: Please click here to contact epictraining@mlh.org to let them know you will not need to train on Epic. You can sign up to use Epic Care Link for read only access to the MLH medical record without any required training [Click here to sign up starting July 8](#)

IF YOU ARE A COMMUNITY PHYSICIAN WHO NEEDS READ ONLY ACCESS: Epic Care Link will provide you with read-only access to the medical record. No training is required. [Click here to sign up starting July 8](#)

IF YOU MAINTAIN FULL HOSPITAL PRIVILEGES AND INTEND TO CONTINUE AT THAT LEVEL:

You are required to complete Epic training with MLH unless you have significant Epic experience and are able to test out of training.

Applications to test out were required by **June 30**, with the test to be taken by **July 12**.

For providers who will not test out of Epic training, you should have registered for training by **June 28**.
